

Canada-United States-Mexico Agreement (CUSMA)

Certification of origin under the Canada-United States-Mexico Agreement (CUSMA) is not required to follow a prescribed format but must contain a set of minimum data requirements as set out in Annex 5-A of the agreement.

You may complete the attached template or provide certification in another format that includes all necessary data elements for a claim for preferential tariff treatment.

COMPLETION INSTRUCTIONS:

Certifier: Indicate if you are the Exporter, Producer, or Importer from the drop down menu.

Is this a Blanket Certification?: If the certification covers multiple shipments of identical goods for a specified period of up to 12 months, select "YES" from the drop down and complete the From and To dates in the applicable fields. If this is a one-time certification, select "NO" and enter a unique identifier in the Invoice # field.

Certifier Details: Provide the certifier's name, address (including country), telephone number and email address.

Exporter Details: Provide the exporter's name, address (including country), e-mail address and telephone number if different from the certifier. This information is not required if the producer is completing the certification of origin and does not know the identity of the exporter. The address of the exporter shall be the place of export of the good in a Party's territory.

Producer Details: Provide the producer's name, address (including country), e-mail address and telephone number, if different from the certifier or exporter or, if there are multiple producers, state "Various" or provide a list of producers. A person that wishes for this information to remain confidential may state "Available upon request by importing authorities". The address of a producer shall be the place of production of the good in a Party's territory.

Importer Details: If the certification is completed by the Exporter or Producer, provide, if known, the importer's name, address, e-mail address and telephone number. The address of the importer shall be in a Party's territory.

Description of Goods: Use the drop down to indicate if you will be listing the product details on the template or providing a separate list to be included with the certification.

Provide a description of the good(s) and the HS tariff classification of the good(s) to the 6-digit level. The description should be sufficient to relate it to the certified good(s). Indicate the origin criterion (a,b,c, or d) by using the Origin Criterion key at the bottom of the template.

If providing a separate listing, indicate the invoice number or other unique identifier related to the list of goods. The description, classification and origin criterion must be included on the listing.

Certifier's Signature/Date Signed: The certification *must* be signed and dated by the certifier.
