

## OGD DATA REQUIREMENTS Transport Canada - Tires

## ELECTRONIC DATA INTERCHANGE (EDI) - Transport Canada

The following table outlines the data elements for Transport Canada's Service Option for Tires required at the time of importation.

Data Element	Business Rule/Value
Product Brand Name	The name of a product of a particular make or trademark
Product Type/Size/Quantity of Tires	The kind/class and dimensions of the tire
Import Reason Code	<ul> <li>Sale</li> <li>Export</li> <li>Modification</li> <li>Not Regulated</li> <li>Testing</li> <li>Retread</li> </ul>
Import Date Compliance Indicator	This indicator is used to indicate that tire complied with Transport Canada regulations on the date of its completion.
Tire Import ID. Number (TIIN)	The Tire Importer Identification Number assigned by Transport Canada to the importer for the import of tires for retread.
Tire Completion Compliance	Transmit field when importing tires and if import reason code is not equal to 6. Tires must be clean of soil.
Manufacturer's Name, Address, Postal Code, Telephone Number & Email Address

## **PENALTIES**

Any corporation that imports tires that do not comply with the safety standards made pursuant to paragraph 17(1) of the Motor Vehicle Safety Act is guilty of an offense and is liable:

- (a) on summary conviction, to a fine not exceeding \$200,000; or
- (b) on indictment, to a fine not exceeding \$2 million.

Any person who imports tires which do not comply with the safety standards made pursuant to paragraph 17(2) of the Motor Vehicle Safety Act is guilty of an offense and is liable:

- (a) on summary conviction, to a fine not exceeding \$4,000 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months, or to both; or
- (b) on indictment, to a fine not exceeding \$20,000 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding two year, or to both.
